The Be Kind Initiative

Catrina Withler, Kiana Moshaver, Jamie Samoyloff and Charlotte Hanna, Grade 10 leadership students from Penticton Secondary School, provided Council with a presentation on 'The Be Kind Initiative' which launched at Penticton Secondary School on September 20, 2019. The leadership students requested that Council proclaim the third March of 2020 as "Be Kind Day".

Council proclaimed March 20, 2020 as "Be Kind Day" in the City of Penticton.

Public Skating Rink Society

Drew Barnes provided Council with a presentation on a public skating rink in Penticton. Council directed staff to report back on the feasibility of the proposed outdoor public skating rink.
