- The City contracts Dog Control services.
- The City owns the dwelling and kennel facilities located at 2330 Dartmouth Drive.
- Kennels provide a temporary home to lost and/or abandoned dogs.



Dog Control Overview

The Dog Control Contractor:

 provides a safe environment for lost and abandoned dogs until they are claimed by their rightful owner or adopted by a new family.





Dog Control Overview

- investigates dog attacks, bites, barking, nuisance and a variety of other dog related issues.
- issues warnings and/or tickets to owners who do not adhere to municipal bylaws such as running at large, dogs on the beach, unleashed dogs, unlicenced dogs, etc.





Dog Control Goals

- To provide a safe, secure and healthy environment for impounded dogs.
- To educate the public about the Dog Control Bylaw and regulations including the requirement to licence dogs.
- To find homes for unclaimed dogs.
