

- ✓ The Proposal are presented in the order that they are in the report.
- ✓ Recommendations were taken to the Transportation Committee on June 27, 2012
- ✓ They also recommended that Council Support the recommendations in the same order as presented in the Report.



Sunday Service 1 hour earlier start \$ 2,000

- ✓ 0.24% in Muni Cost/Ride
- √ For same Muni Cost/Ride require:
 - √ 1,015 additional riders per year
 - √ 19 riders/Sunday



Sunday Service additional route

\$ 13,000

- ✓ 1.53% in Muni Cost/Ride
- √ For same Muni Cost/Ride require:
 - √ 6,600 additional riders per year
 - √ 127 riders/Sunday



Special Event allowance

\$ 3,200

- ✓ 0.38% in Muni Cost/Ride
- ✓ Would only use if there was an event we wanted to provide service for
- ✓ Service Level decision



Increase Frequency Route 5

\$144,200

- ➤ 17.02% in Muni Cost/Ride
- ➤ For same Muni Cost/Ride require:
 - > 115,000 additional riders per year
 - > 370 riders/Day
 - > 175% more than predicted by BC Transit (41,800)
