

Overview

- Lakeview and Fairview Cemeteries
- Lakeview is maintained by contracted services. Fairview is maintained by City staff
- 2016/17 Lakeview Cemetery expansion has increased capacity to meet the needs of the community to 2025

Lakeview Cemetery is 14.7 acres 7,500 plots 1,500 cremation plots

1,525 niches in columbarium 45 niches in mausoleum
