- · Bleach or aerosol containers with contents remaining
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants or antifreeze
- · Pesticides with the words DANGER. WARNING or POISON
- Sharps/needles

TIP!

Soft plastics no longer have to be sorted before



The following flexible plastic items may be dropped off at a depot for recycling. They *cannot* be placed in your residential recycling carts.



- Crinkly (e.g. candy wrappers)
- Doesn't stretch (e.g. cereal bags)
- Foil lining (e.g. chip bags)
- Sealed for freshness (e.g. stand-up pouches)
- · Zipper lock bags
- Woven net bags

- · Not crinkly (e.g. overwrap on pop can flats)
- Can poke your thumb through it (e.g. overwrap on toilet paper)
- Single material (e.g. bulk or produce bags)
- For carrying / keeping clean (e.g. plastic shopping bags)
