

# YES! Put in your Recycling Bin

## PAPER & CARDBOARD



- Paper & cardboard
- Newspaper & flyers
- Magazines & phone-books (NO books)
- Paper bags
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper gift wrap & gift bags
- Shredded paper (contain in clear plastic bag; this is the only time bags are allowed)
- Paper gift wrap & gift bags
- Paper bags for pet food, flour, sugar, etc.
- Paper carry-out trays
- Greeting cards

## CONTAINERS



- Plastic bottles, jars & jugs
- Plastic trays & clamshell packaging
- Take-out cups, bowls & lids
- Soup & sauce cartons
- Metal cans & lids
- Aluminum foils & trays
- Plastic packaging for toys, batteries, etc.
- Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.
- Plastic cleaning & hygiene bottles
- Plastic garden pots
- Empty aerosol cans
- Caps, tops, lids & pumps

## Keep these items **OUT** of your Recycling Bin



- Glass • Plastic bags, soft plastics & overwrap • Foam packaging • Paper towels & napkins  
Light bulbs • Batteries • Electronics • Scrap metal • Furniture • Clothing • Sharps / needles

### DON'T FORGET:

Rinse containers

Squish & flatten

Place materials *loosely* inside bin (NO BAGS)
